COMPLIANCE APPROACH: INVESTIGATIVE OUTCOMES

Non-Disciplinary

- Take no further action
- Warning letter
- Educational disposition
- Negotiated resolution
- Other

Disciplinary

- Refer elsewhere (TSSA, ESA)
- Change internal process
- Reprimand
- Administrative Penalties



COMPLIANCE APPROACH: INTEGRATING APS

- OOC has adopted a zero-quota philosophy, meaning Assessors do not have targets to meet in terms of issuing APs, and OOC has no revenue goals associated to AP funds.
- There are no automatic APs, meaning no AP will be issued based on performance data alone.
 Assessors may only consider issuing an AP once an investigation has determined non-compliance.
- There are **no** "AP cases" at OOC. APs represent an important new tool, or outcome, that can be issued by Assessors upon the conclusion of an investigation.
- Investigations are more likely to result in an AP where an assessor finds there has been a public safety shortfall, poor conduct, and/or repetition of an offence.
- OOC will be issuing APs following investigations, as of May 1st, 2024.




ASSESSORS

- Assessors perform their function in keeping with OOC's Code of Conduct for compliance personnel.
- Only an Assessor may determine, at their own discretion, whether to issue a penalty.
- Concerns regarding public safety and priority projects are handled with the highest urgency by the investigation team.



AP ISSUANCE PROCESS






LATE LOCATE: COMPLAINT SCENARIO



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
LATE LOCATE: POOR CONDUCT SCENARIO

MYTHS AND FACTS

Myth

Absolute liability means OOC will assess about \$25 million in late locate penalties against members every month.

OOC plans to use the AP monies it collects to fund its operations and payroll.

Come May, OOC will retroactively issue APs for poor performance in 2024.

Fact

There are no "automatic APs" in OOC's compliance process.

The regulation has strict rules about how OOC can use funds it collects through the issuance of APs.

While Assessors take past conduct into account, no penalties will be issued retroactively.
